## Commemorating 100 years this Remembrance Day

Thornbury's Remembrance Day parade will start at 2pm from St Mary's Street car park before heading to St Mary's Church where wreaths will be laid at the foot of the war memorial.

In Almondsbury a series of events to mark the centenary of the start of the First World War will be continued with their Remembrance Day service starting at 10.45 am in St Mary's Church.

The service will be followed by an opportunity for reflection with tributes and remembrance at the war memorial cross in Sundays Hill.

Nearby villages will also be holding their own services and parades. Residents of Tytherington will be joining a parade to the church at 10.45am.

The Wotton and Charfield branch of the Royal British Legion is to cooperate with Wotton Town Council, the churches and the Wotton Silver Band, in their Remembrance Sunday commemoration.

This will conclude the "Poppy fortnight", where volunteers house-to-house а collection around the town for the welfare of ex-service people and their families.

The parade in Wotton will set off from the Chipping at 10.30am, arriving at St.Mary's Church in time for the two minutes' silence at 11am and a remembrance service.

Following the service, the parade will reform to march to the War Memorial for the laying of wreaths.


The first remembrance event in Dursley is to be held at 10.30am at the War Memorial on Hopton Green in Cam. This parade is organised by the RBL on behalf of Cam Parish Council.

Wreath laying on the memorial will take place just after 11am. The parade then marches past the Memorial for a salute.

The second parade is in Dursley Town Centre. Groups will assemble in the May Lane bus station at 2.30pm and then march down to St James' church. This will be followed by a service in the church which ends at about 4pm. Wreaths are laid on the memorial gates and the parade marches back to May Lane.

The Remembrance event in North Nibley will begin at the war memorial at 10.45am.

St John's Church, Slimbridge will be holding its annual Remembrance Day Service on Sunday, 9th November 10.00am. During service there will also be two dedications, one of our new Plague listing the names of soldiers from Slimbridge who died in the First World War, and secondly of our beautiful new Glazed Screen which was so expertly carved by Slimbridge carpenter, Alan Smith.




